"When we see a woman with a questionable mammogram, we explain what the results mean," says Dr. Brian McKinley. "We do a comprehensive, individualized risk assessment for her, and based on results, help her decide what to do moving forward."

High Standards of Care

The GHS Breast Health Program offers state-of-the-art diagnostics, including

mammography, breast MRI, ultrasound, stereotactic breast biopsy, and ultrasound-guided biopsy.

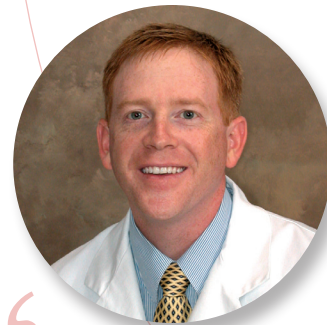
"We have a fellowship-trained breast imager on site, and all biopsies are performed by one of our four radiologists who specialize only in breast imaging and procedures," says Dr. McKinley. Women who need surgery have the expertise of fellowship-trained surgical oncologists and surgeons who focus their practice on breast issues.

Importantly, if a serious concern about your breast health is identified, you can see a breast surgeon within 24 hours.

Women often feel intimidated by doctors, particularly surgeons, and hesitate to ask questions. "I tell women to be persistent questioners of their doctors," Dr. McKinley counters, and he encourages you to be an active participant in your own care. "The driving force behind what we're doing is to take the very best care of you."
